Introduction:

You know the parts of a computer well. Let us revise the parts and learn something more about them. Before that, let us learn some new words.

Device: A thing. For example, a pencil is a *device* with which you write

Input: Take in. For example, our ears are our body's *input*. We listen with our ears. We *take in* what someone has told us.

Process: Think about something. For example, you *process*, or *think about* the question asked by your teacher.

Output: Give out. For example, when you give out the answer to your teacher with your mouth, you give an output.



This is a **monitor.** The monitor shows you pictures and videos. So, it is an **output** device for the computer.



This is a **keyboard**. The keyboard lets you type letters to someone. So, it is an **input** device for the computer.



This is a **mouse**. The mouse lets you draw things and click on buttons. So, it is an input device for the computer.



These are **speakers**. Speakers let you hear songs played from the computer. So, they are an **output** device for the





This is a **web cam**. The web cam shows your face to your friends and relatives. So, it is an input device for the computer.



This is the **CPU**. CPU takes input from the keyboard and mouse, and then shows output on the monitor or plays music on the speaker. The CPU is the brain of the computer. So, it is

a processing device.






