Activity Steps

- 1. **Introduce** the video topic to students by saying: Today we're going to watch a video exploring how digital media tries to hook you and what you can do about it.
- 2. Show the video Teen Voices: The Pressure to Stay Connected (3:19 minutes). (Note: The video is also available in Spanish, and you can also use the video player to turn on subtitles.)
