Work Sheet: 01-PS-24-WS



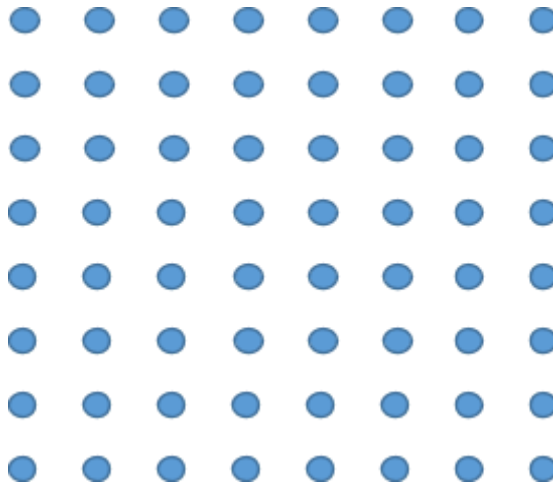
Introduction:
