Activity Steps

- 1. **Introduce** the video topic to students by saying: Today we're going to watch a video exploring how to chat safely with people you meet online.
- 2. Show the video Teen Voices: Who You're Talking to Online (3:27 minutes). (Note: The video is also available in Spanish, and you can also use the video player to turn on subtitles.)
- 3. **Lead** a class discussion exploring the questions below. **Optional:** You can also distribute the Student Handout and have students respond to the questions prior to group or whole-class discussion.

Discussion Questions

1. What are some of the benefits -- and risks -- of talking with people online that you don't know face-to-face?

Sample responses:

Benefits:

- In online communities, you can connect with people who have similar interests.
- It can be easier to share and be more open about hardships you're going through in a way that may not be possible with your face-to-face friends.

Risks:

- You don't fully know who you are talking to, and therefore you can't completely trust them.
- You don't know if they have bad motivations or intentions.
