Discussion Questions


1. The Digital Citizens pledged to travel safely on the internet. What was one thing you learned from the Digital Citizens?

Sample responses:

- Keep track of how much time you spend online. If you lose track of time, you miss out on other activities like going outside with friends.
- · Always ask a grown-up before you go online.
- Keep your information private, like your name and address.
- · when you are online, talk only to friends you know.
- Never start a fight online.

- **2.** Why is it a good idea to set a time limit when using technology? Sample responses:
 - So you don't miss out on other activities that are important to you.
