

Video Discussion



What You'll Need: • Video • Student Handout • Student Handout (Spanish)

Activity Steps

1. **Introduce** the video topic to students by saying: *Today we're going to watch a video that explores how you can create a social media presence that reflects the real you.*
2. **Show** the Teen Voices: Who Are You on Social Media? video (5:13 minutes). (Note: The video is also available in Spanish, and you can also use the video player to turn on subtitles.)
3. **Lead** a class discussion exploring the questions below.
Optional: You can also distribute the Student Handout and have students respond to the questions prior to group or whole-class discussion.

Discussion Questions

1. *How do you curate your life on social media?*
 - Answers will vary. Highlight examples that the teens in the video shared like:
 - only sharing certain types of pictures
 - only sharing posts or images related to one activity or hobby
 - posting content that is relevant to certain audiences (college sports scouts, specific groups of friends, etc....)
2. *Which perspectives stood out to you in the video?*
 - Answers will vary.
3. *Which did you agree or disagree with? Why?*
 - Answers will vary.



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
