Activity Steps

- 1. **Introduce** the video topic to students by saying: Today we're going to watch a video where you'll learn the "Internet Traffic Light" poem to help you remember what to do if you come across a site that isn't appropriate for you.
- 2. **Show** the <u>Internet Traffic Light</u> video (0:54 minutes). (Note: The video is also available in Spanish, and you can also use the video player to turn on subtitles.)
- 3. **Lead** a class discussion exploring the questions below.

Discussion Questions

- 1. The Digital Citizens stayed safe by using the internet traffic light. What does green mean? Can you think of some examples of green sites?
 - Sample responses:
 - Green means sites that are "just right" for you.
 - A green site means it is appropriate and safe for children my age to visit.
 - The site is at the right reading level for me.
 - (Students may provide specific examples.)
- **2.** What should you do when you find a yellow website? Sample responses:
 - A yellow site means "slow down" and be cautious. The site might not be safe for me.
 - I should leave the site, or ask a trusted adult for permission to visit it.
- **3.** What should you do if you accidentally go to a website that isn't right for you? Sample responses:
 - I should leave the site and find a "green" site that is appropriate for me.
 - I should ask a trusted adult for permission to visit it.
