

Patterns in Words Lesson Plan: Class 03 / IPP / 02



Goal of the lesson: To make the children understand what are patterns and the different patterns in words.

Procedure Details

- 1. Start with asking the children what do they understand by the word pattern?
- 2. Slide 2 and 3 has different explanations for the word pattern which students may not be able to understand. By using examples in the slides that follow they should be able to grasp them.
- 3. The simplest pattern to understand is patterns on fabric. Slides 3 starts with this.
- 4. Slide 3 to Slide 7 talks about patterns on fabric. For each design shown you can ask them for more examples. You can also take up designs not discussed in the slide. In fact kids can be asked to come up with more examples on designs.
- 5. Slides 8 to 10 talks about patterns in humans. The example on the slide is about a kid following a specific pattern every day before she boards her school bus.
- 6. You can ask few students to say about the pattern which they follow every day before they come to school. Ask them whether they would follow the same pattern on weekends and holidays.
- 7. They can be asked to discuss about the patterns followed by their parents and siblings
- 8. Slides 11 to 14 talks about patterns in numbers.
- 9. Remaining slides starting 15 talks about patterns in words. There are 3 rhymes taken as examples in the slides. Help the students in identifying sound patterns using these rhymes
- 10. Explain to them that though the words don't match by having the same alphabets they do match with each other because of the same sound.
- 11. Next discuss with them about the second word pattern which is spelling pattern.
- 12. 3 examples are given in slides 22, 23 and 24 for the students to understand spelling patterns.
- 13. You can ask students to come up with few more examples on spelling patterns
- 14. Give them the worksheets which will help them to consolidate what they have learnt in the class
