

# Introduction To Find Patterns Lesson Plan: Class 02 / PS / 15

Overall goal of the lesson: Children will learn about searching for Patterns

Prior knowledge required: Knowledge of the Spelling Bee (done in Std. 1).

**MODULE 1:** 

Module time: 35 minutes

**Goal:** To give a brief introduction to finding words and patterns.

Description: Children will learn about searching for patterns with the help of this activity and finding commonly

known words in the grid.

# Material required:

# **Physical:**

- 1. One copy of the worksheet (Find Patterns) per child.
- 2. Writing material to solve the worksheet: pencil and eraser.

#### **Electronic:**

PPT Presentation for Introduction to Find Patterns.

#### **Procedure Summary:**

- 1. Distribute the worksheets (Find Patterns) to the children.
- 2. Read through the worksheet and walk them through the searches.

### **Procedure Details:**

- 1. Start the class by talking to the children about if they recall about searching for common words in a grid.
- 2. Step them through the revision slide on searching colours
- 3. Follow the slides to teach them to search for words with more than 3 letters related to Animals
  - a. Introduce Bottom to Top search
- 4. Guide them through the slide on Directions
  - a. Introduce Bottom to Top slanting direction
- 5. Introduce random pattern search "AAB", "ABA"
- 6. Explain the activities on the sheet using the PPT
